It is debatable as to when the average person gives up his faith in an ideal world. Is it at 5, when aunt Sega and uncle Nintendo start to replace mom and dad? Is it at 9, after the first sexual abuse in your own family, school or church? Is it at 13, when you begin to see through the educational scam called school? Is it at 15, when a first hot night is followed only by a cold shoulder? Is it at 17, when the screaming social injustice in this world begins to creep under your skin? Or at 18, when you begin to figure out that most politicians are egomaniacs? Perhaps at 19, when you run into the words “youth unemployment” for the first time? How about 21, when your dream career turns into a mere job and frustration begins to sink in? Is it at 24, when your supposed dream partner drops the mask and the first marriage is rocked? Or at 30, when your trusted (but bad) bank sells you trash and you are now indebted for the rest of your life?

Life looked so good in the ads. The whole world is waiting for you; everything is possible, heaven is the limit. People, who were paid to look happy, told the world with choreographed smiles and supernaturally white teeth how fantastic life is as long as you buy their product. But more and more are zapping away from this kind of scam. They have lost faith in a golden world sugarcoated by ads. They know that the media belong to a profit oriented industry that is more loyal to big money than the truth. In real life it seems that greed, money and power rules. Love will grow cold, someone once said. Anyone talking too much about honesty, trust or credibility, is automatically suspected — he has something to sell, to hide, he probably works for a church or is a professional politician.

Therefore, society switched into a hangover mood. Many have been caught up by the harsh reality of life, which is summed up in seven words: work and earn, pay taxes and burn! Life became disenchanting. Dreams of castles in the air were shot to pieces by bills in the mail. Former bastions of truth, and the pillars of moral authority like politics, banks, churches, schools and family have failed and are mostly clueless. This is how the majority of people today became generally insecure, disillusioned, disappointed and frustrated. The mood in many is turning sour; some are becoming downright angry. Or they silently resign — there is nothing you can do, is there?

But you *can* do something about this! There is hope, more than you probably thought. In the pages that follow, I have a few surprises for you. It would be an understatement to call them electrifying. When I discovered these things for myself, I had quite a few sleepless nights out of sheer excitement. I will not be astonished if you lose a few hours of sleep yourself. There is a good reason why this booklet is called *The Re-Invention of the World*.

Did you know, for example,

- that it is technically possible (since 1971) to run cars with water instead of gas and heat a house through central heating with one liter water per day? (water as fuel, the supplier of energy)

Implosive Brown's Gas, named after its Bulgarian inventor, Yull Brown, has five times the energy potential of petrol. Ships literally swim in their own fuel.

- that the technical groundwork has already been laid to create a new kind of nuclear energy that is completely free of any radiation?

Nuclear physicists in Switzerland have discovered that supernovas radiate an extremely powerful emission of ultra-high-frequency rays that arrive on earth without any delay and can be turned into inexhaustible electric energy.

- that malaria is curable?

There is cheap (but for many Africans still unaffordable) medicine that suppresses the symptoms of malaria. But a cheap tea made out of *artemisia annua* anamed contains so much *artemisinin*, that more than 95% of all who contracted malaria can be cured. Millions do not die of malaria, but of the lie that malaria is not curable.

- that electricity can be broadcast like a cell phone or radio signal – and that since 1896? Since then, power lines, grids and electric meters are actually redundant.

Nikolai Tesla first was wirelessly broadcasting electricity in 1896 from Denver (USA). He offered this technology to the American government. They declined.

- that greed and ego, the scourges of humanity, are curable?

Both are mental slave drivers against which we are not left powerless. There is a simple and effective method to get rid of them. Read on.

- that churches have very little to do with the original message of Jesus Christ? He preached the Kingdom of God – what came was the church. He never founded a religion or asked anyone to build church buildings.

Jesus came to deliver mankind from man-made religion, not to bring a new one. He is inviting anyone to become a citizen in his Kingdom, with all rights, privileges, and the best constitution in the world.

- that glyconutrients can help a human body to regain a large part of our (almost lost) ability to self-diagnose and self-heal?

Glyconutrients, a complex of polysaccharides found in nature, are vital elements for intercellular communication, the intra-net of our body. Today, they are near extinction in most diets. First experiences of those that take them again are even beyond high expectations; some speak of the biggest medical sensation of the century.

- that it is possible to get 100% return per year on your money?

Since about the year 2,000 more money is made with money globally than with goods and services. Hidden amongst a myriad of charlatans and systemic fraud there are some financial solutions in existence that have been tried and tested by the most skeptical of financial specialists and that could lead to a financial exodus from poverty for many. Until now, such conditions have only been open to a small elitist group of the super-privileged rich.

- that 98% of all people are highly talented at the time of birth? After finishing school, that number drops to 2%. But there are alternatives to systemic dulling.

Almost the entire educational system has been hijacked by the market to be a supplier of “wheels for the machine”. But there are alternatives. One is a model proposed by Jan Simson in his book *We Need a Completely Different Kind of Education*.

- that after saying farewell to genetically altered seeds, Indian farmers have brought in a harvest that was two to three times bigger than before?

In the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh about 100,000 farmers took their lives into their own hands, pressed hard by greedy land-owners and companies selling them overpriced, gene-manipulated and hybrid seeds. They found an ingenious solution that many at first laughed about. Now even the agricultural ministry has asked about the secret.

Why do we not hear about this? Who suppresses it? And why?

What would our life look like without electricity bills? Without civilization diseases, — burnout, stress? If you had the choice between filling your car with a garden hose or a gas pump nozzle, what would you do? If you could heat your house with Brown's gas or any other truly free form of energy, would you still climb your roof and screw on those "new" solar panels? Or ponder about other dinosaur technologies like hydroelectric power, wind energy, conventional nuclear energy, wooden pellets, gas, oil or coal? How would our air quality be if we would burn water for fuel?

What would your financial situation look like if, instead of getting that ridiculous 2% interest rate from a bank, you could get 100% interest per year? How many cases of divorce, suicide, panic attacks, depressions, sleepless nights and a lifestyle of addictions and flight reactions could be avoided when your debt could be turned into credit? Contrary to the ceaseless propaganda about "limited financial resources", there is actually enough money on the planet to turn everyone into a millionaire. We do not have a problem with availability of funds; we have a problem with its *distribution*.

What if all our neighbors would be friends instead of being notoriously suspicious and file cases against each other at the drop of a hat? What if we would begin to live again in multi-generational extended families – clans and new tribes – instead of condemning each age group to go at life all alone? What if yuppies, seniors and single mothers, would no longer have to crawl into their cells of loneliness called a single household? What if more and more small families would say farewell to taking out that mortgage for their single-family house that ties them for the rest of their life, not only to a bank, but also to a job that has to pay for it all?

What if we would start to share what we have, instead of ruthlessly taking as much as we can and defending it against all aggressors? What if we would begin to share our lawn mowers, drilling machines, vacation homes and cars (there; I said it!) with those on our street and in our neighborhood? What would our city look like if those that are rich would share with the poor from their surplus and would not just advertise their own egos and good deeds through "social sponsoring," but would simply support the common good?

What would your mood be if you could get up in the morning and do exactly what you were born to do, not what your current job position dictates for you? What if your profession is your true vocation? What if you could earn your money by doing what you are best at, instead of doing a job anyone else can fill in for?

Maybe you say, “That’s too visionary! Let’s keep our feet on the ground.”

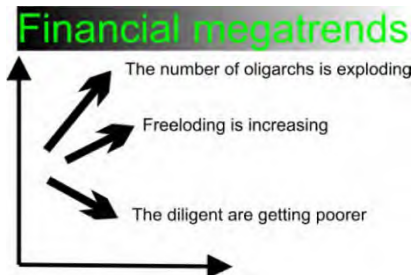
But I am sure you are aware that something has gone terribly wrong with this world. It has gone completely out of whack. Life on the planet has become disfigured beyond recognition. Because of the level of air pollution, some citizens of Shanghai already carry with them a balloon of imported country-air. Man is becoming part of a gigantic machine, just like in the film *The Matrix*. Even before people show up at their work -place they are tired, overworked, irritated, stressed, and overwhelmed. Most families have imploded long ago and have turned into a flat-sharing community. Many singles cannot even differentiate any more between love and lust. Fewer and fewer people know the answer to the question: Who am I, and what am I doing here? During lunch breaks and after work most are busy to forget what they did their entire day. They dive into pastimes, sports, TV-soap, novels and Sudoku. They run away into a parallel universe full of gambling, golf, apps or video games, and briefly surface for food. Even then, they slowly but surely poison themselves with pseudo food targeted at satisfying their taste buds, full of artificial aromas and colors, obscene amounts of sugar and interesterified fatty acids, turning their own body into a toxic waste dump. They are even paying for it, as if someone has dulled all of us down completely and left us in a coma.

The world of work, economy, politics, and culture has been infested with a cancer that runs rampant. Its symptoms are everywhere: shameless greed of individuals and groups, and fear and blatant materialism. If you switch on your TV, you see a never-ending stream of ads interrupted by chaos, crisis, catastrophes, and shows with degraded casting. The headlines are dominated by the latest craze of pop idols or cats that survive a fall from the 10th floor, spiced by ever-new economic horror stories and tales of oligarchs that play monopoly and divide the world amongst themselves. The media is selling us a dulling mix of the latest escapades of pathological power seekers on their ego trips, the latest fashion terror, recipes of Chicken Mediterranean and the shrill mantras of self-appointed sex-experts. Have you ever noticed that even the television guides in our supermarkets all look absolutely the same, probably even with the same blond posing on them all? All this, while the world plunges more and more into cheap nationalism and racism and is tossed about by bigoted religion and fanatic atheism. As if on cue, the Pope appears every Christmas and Easter and warns the world to be peaceful and considerate. Nevertheless, the bottom line is that even he is not much more than the head of a highly profitable religious insurance empire that does not want to lose customers. Simple words just bless the mess, and sweep everything under the carpet. The icing on the cake is our daily dosage of war, climate change, terrorism, violence, crime and pollution. And now for the weather...

No wonder people are plagued by depression, mental illnesses, phobias, sleeplessness, diabetes, stress, high blood pressure and migraine. Is it really that bad? **Worse, say the experts.**

Recently ten professors from different fields put their heads together and wrote a book in German titled, *Höllensterz und Hoffnung* meaning *Falling to Hell and Hope*. The point of their book is that the world as we know it is facing a mega-collapse. All previous predictions of doom like those of the Club of Rome have been child's play compared to what we face right now. All those partial crises like overfishing, wars, stock market and bank crashes, mass migrations or the education crisis have linked up to create a unique and historic meta-crisis. This accumulated mother-of-all-crises is irreversible; the entire Western civilization is in free fall. Their conclusion is that there is no hope as long as we do not absolutely challenge greed as the foundation for our economy and find our way back to trusting in God in completely new ways. Without trust, no society can exist. However, trust requires truthfulness; we will have to come back to that later.

Two German financial advisors, Matthias Weik and Marc Friedrich, have recently written a book called *Der größte Raubzug der Geschichte* (The Biggest Robbery in History). They explain the systemic reason why the diligent are bound to become poorer and the rich richer. They are quoting Hans Tietmeyer, a former state secretary in the finance ministry of Germany, saying: "Most politicians are *unaware* as to how much they are under the control of the financial markets and are actually ruled by them." They conclude that money really does rule the world. Because those that benefit most from the status quo do everything in their power to make sure that nothing will change. I say that *nothing will change until something or someone comes along who is stronger than money.*



Oligarchy is the rulership of a handful of rich people. The number of billionaires is currently exploding. According to a *dpa* news item the number of billionaires has grown to 1,867 worldwide in 2014. Half of them are Chinese and Americans. Many have doubled their assets in 2013. Add to this about 12 million more millionaires, one million in Germany alone.

Why is the media silent about all of this? Why didn't you ever see anything about Brown's gas, glyconutrients or artemisinin *on TV*? **Because we have the best media money can buy.** Like many others, former German TV-anchorwoman Eva Herman has exposed in her book, *The Media Cartel*, the mesh between company lobbies, government and media. Our daily pre-chewed news productions, infotainment and sensational journalism are nothing more than a distraction by a *disinformation* media. "Banks, politicians and media have long formed a cartel," says German precious metal specialist Hans J. Bocker. English comedian and activist Russel Brand (in his book *Revolution*) speaks of a manipulative tyranny that streamlines changes to entire cultures using the media.

I have another name for this greed-driven cartelization: **the icing of the world**. It is the result of four factors working together: globalized greed, debt overload of governments, an academia that has gone haywire, and a bought media. These four factors together are the *ICE-machine*. It produces something like Antarctic glaciations that has paralyzed all of society. The icing of the world works like this:



Factor 1: Greed. Where greed has become the key factor driving our economy, we should expect that it is aggressively capturing, expanding, and consolidating markets. Greed will also actively defend positions of power and monopoly and stop at nothing in doing so. American investor George Soros once said, “Markets are essentially immoral. Moral people will stand no chance to prevail there.” The greedy ruthlessness of multi-nationals, investment companies and financial empires like Black Rock, have only one thing in mind: to gain the monopoly. I call that GG, **globalized greed**. This unholy GG-cow is untouchable. Why? Because, you do not slaughter the cow that you milk.

Factor 2: Debt. Almost all governments of the world are over-indebted (as the result of a specific political strategy) and flatter the GG-cow because they need its milk. Our governments, — through taxation or unofficial ties to the shadow economy or corruption (or both) — are completely and utterly at the mercy of big capital and its pitiless mechanisms. Governments have therefore sanctioned our gigantic GG-cow and given her a halo of untouchability. One hand washes the other.

Factor 3: “Science has usurped the monopoly to explain the world”, writes German psychotherapist, doctor and author Manfred Lütz in his book *Bluff. Die Fälschung der Welt*. (Bluff. The Falsification of the World). The true high priests of a society in bondage to science are no longer ordained in church but graduate from universities. It is a (scientific) fact that a large part of the study of medicine is shaped by the pharmaceutical industry. They are very interested in loyal salespeople for their high-priced products.

Factor 4: The Media. The media is closing ranks and making sure that no politically incorrect information that could endanger this system leaks to the public. This is done through tight control. Most media houses are in the hands of media moguls and a very small number of clans that control the media intake of the populace.

Now I still need to tell you what ICE stands for: Intentional Corruptive Environment. Corruption is the abuse of bestowed power or position for personal benefit. Lord Acton said it like this: *Power corrupts; absolute power corrupts absolutely.*

The Big Bluff – how do we respond?

Many “investigative” journalists and an army of whistle blowers like Edward Snowden or Julian Assange, founder of *Wikileaks*, blow their whistles and cry foul. Angry demonstrators, hundreds of protest initiatives like *Occupy* or *Transparency International* and a myriad of political parties point their fingers at the problems. Spanish political newcomer party *Podemos* (we can do it!) has declared war on *The Caste*, the power cartel between politicians and economics. But what good is the sharpest analysis if there is no practical alternative? Many media houses, and a long list of alternative internet portals, and conspiracy experts like John Perkins (*Confessions of an Economic Hitman*) or Edward Griffin with his book about the FED (*The Creature from Jekyll Island*) do their detective work and have gone out to tell the world about the real story behind the published story. Their goal is to inform about dirty secrets and create awareness, ripping the mask off the face of the monster. They serve a crowd that thrives on one sentence: *I told you so!* There are large fan clubs, — shivering with conspiracy-fever but actually, simply hypnotized by fear — ready to discuss, if it is 300 families that rule the world (the thesis of Robert Coleman) or only seven. Nevertheless, what is the value of the best conspiracy theory *if there is no tangible alternative to it?* A diagnosis is not yet the therapy and pointing at problems does not solve them yet.

But there is a solution out there; a true alternative to a world gone haywire. Tokens of this alternative are *game changers*, groundbreaking and epoch-making insights that create a completely different scenario. Christian Hörstel, a former senior editor in the ARD, (German mainstream media outlet) said, *“There is information that our mainstream media is withholding from the public. If it were known, it would radically change their perspective; game changing information.”*

Many have concluded that they ended up in the wrong movie, that they have become the victims of a gigantic bluff. Dr. Manfred Lütz says what many don't dare to speak out loud: “The world in which we live is one big spectacular falsification.” People who smell that fake, often withdraw into their little bubbles and milieus (my club, my clique, my church) and live a life of self-imposed naivety inside their small social gang. “Reality escapes them”, says Lutz, “hidden behind a masquerade created by an artificial world that knows nothing of real death, love, good, evil or God. It is the fake world created by science, psychology, media, the economy and plastic religion.”

How should we react?

Should we get angry, give up, ignore all of this and bury ourselves in work? Or is there something we could do? *We can; read on.* But many are still doggedly locked into a head-in-the-sand mode. “The great majority lives in complete political and social denial”, says German publicist Günther Ederer in his book *Träum weiter Deutschland* (Keep on Dreaming, Germany).

This denial is the result of a **conditioning**. Have humans been tamed? And if yes, by whom? If lions can be tamed and made to jump through hoops, so can we? Lions were not born to perform in a circus and doze in a cage; they long to be back in their savannah. We humans all know a similar feeling, that deep-seated homesickness, *the longing to be in a land we have never been*. I call this the wild goose instinct:

Imagine wild geese that were turned into domesticated geese with clipped wings and a clipped heart. Their life is now confined between bowl, pen and fence, treading beaten paths and waiting for the cooking pot. Only twice a year they become nervous when their wild relatives, during migration times, fly over their heads in spring and autumn. That is when their little heart begins to beat faster and their clipped wings twitch. The domesticated geese feel the wild goose in them awaken. Quickly, the sound of the wings of the wild geese fades away, and everything seems to implode. What remain are the bowl, pen, fence, and pot. Was it only a *fata morgana*?

Do you know what happens, if you put some fleas into an empty jar of jam? They start to jump until they hit the lid, the hard border of their small world. Then they will continue to jump just short of the threshold of pain. But if you screw off the lid after some time, the amazing thing is that the fleas will not excitedly jump out into their new found freedom, but will continue to be well-behaved fleas, and stop their jumping at the proper level, right where the lid used to be. Enforced by pain, they have accepted their limit and integrated this as an unchangeable fact into their lives. In other words, they have been conditioned, tamed, trained to even stop trying to get out.

If you do not have some fleas handy for this experiment, take an elephant. Wrap a strong chain around one of its hind legs and tie the elephant to a big tree. Just outside of its reach, you place a bowl of food and wait for three days. Crazy for food the elephant will try to reach that bowl until the chain painfully cuts into its leg. Then you appear back on the scene and hand over the bowl. The animal will be forever grateful to you, its savior. After a while, when the elephant has gotten used to you and the chain that still rubs against that vulnerable spot on its leg, you replace the chain with a rope and the tree with a simple peg. You will see that the elephant still believes that the rope is a chain and the peg is a tree. It responds to the slightest pressure on its leg and accepts defeat. You have now successfully conditioned the animal. Only on rare occasions does this experiment go wrong. Let us say the circus tent is on fire and the elephant gets scared. It “forgets” that it is conditioned, and simply walks off. The “chain” on its leg breaks – just like the rope it was.

If you feel even just a little bit like those domesticated geese, the fleas or the elephant, then I have news for you. *The lid is off, the tree is a peg and you can actually fly. Try it. Take off.* The chain is nothing but a *fata morgana*.

This chain consists of a series of lies. The well-oiled ICE-machine has dished up a fascinatingly long list of bluffs, and lies to the world. Here some of the most devastating icebergs, I mean, lies. You just need to hear them often enough and they begin to sound like familiar truth:

Three percent interest per year is a lot!
Your money is safe with us!
Buy now; pay later!
Americans are always the good guys!
The media is free!

Work is the reason why you live!
The next politician is the best one!
Conspiracy? What conspiracy?
You are an evolved monkey!
Planet earth is 4.5 billion years old!
Fast food is food!
Aspartame is a good substitute for sugar!
More is always better!
Greed is cool!

Don't trust anybody – not even friends!
You can't cure cancer, aids, diabetes or malaria!
You are nobody, a loser, a good-for-nothing
Swine flu is killing us all!

We will lower taxes!
It wasn't us!

People who behave as if they watched it happen.

Producers of fast food and their ad companies.

Coca-Cola, Pepsi and similar companies.

Companies that want to sell us things we don't
need with money we don't have to impress
people we don't like.

Traumatized folks that don't know how to forgive.

Those that make big money with pseudo-cures.

Far too many parents, grandparents and teachers.

Tamiflu and other pharma-producers; the USA;

former French president Sarkozy.

Governments of all times (before elections).

Governments of all times (after elections).

I am sure you can prolong this list substantially. But it is time to no longer focus on the problem, but look for the solution.

Where do we look? Whom do we trust? Who has the moral authority to tell us anything? **Where can we get trustworthy, reliable and impartial answers?** Many have lost their confidence in politics, media, philosophy, government and private institutions. Rightly so. Statistics say that many are turning to comedians, — modern day jesters, —to speak the truth. Still, most set their hopes on politics or money. Or both. Did I already mention how enormously trustworthy most banks have become nowadays?

What about the religions? 84% of the world's populations are religious. But the main reason why people are at each other's throats are for religious reasons, bigoted bickering and fighting. In my many travels, I have learned that those who are insecure — scream. You will not find the truth by listening to the loudest mouth. I have come to a simple conclusion: *Religion is part of a search*. If you find what you were looking for, you stop searching and you no longer need religion. "Religion is a fairy tale for those that are afraid of the darkness," said physicist Stephen Hawking, an atheist. "Atheism is a fairy tale for those that are afraid of the light," says Christian professor of mathematics, John Lennox. I think both are right. I define religion as human inventions of systems of faith. After some time, these evolve into man-made traditions and rituals that are geared at making God gracious and benevolent, without having to change one's own life too much.

And what about the Churches? The Roman-Catholic Church is the market leader at selling insurance against hell. Besides a number of "orthodox" churches that are interwoven with culture, there are about 50,000 protestant churches and denominations plus about 200,000 independent churches, groups and charities, including more well-known religious factions like the Jehovah Witnesses or the Mormons. So, which group is right? Frank Viola, a best-selling author in the USA, has demonstrated in his book *Pagan Christianity* that about 90% of all that Christians do has next to nothing to do with the Bible. They follow human religious conventions and traditions, some of them even imported from other religions. He told me he has been getting death threats from pastors, which means he is probably right. The craze for church buildings, endlessly attending religious events, Easter egg hunts, Christmas trees, clerics dressed like penguins and those prayers to Saint What's-his-name are just the tip of the religious ICE-berg. If you take just five minutes to read in the New Testament, you will find an entirely different message there than what is transpiring in most churches. The American ex-pastor Jim Henderson once invited a friendly atheist, Matt Casper, who was knowledgeable in the Bible, to tour a number of churches together and check their level of alignment to the New Testament. Matt exposed himself to the full dose: lightshows, fog-machines, worship-bands, extended fund appeals and the wallowing in traditions. Finally he had enough and exclaimed in complete bewilderment: "Seriously, did Jesus tell you guys to do that?!"

What did Jesus tell us to do? The core message of God to man is very simple: *Stop running away and come back home. You are loved, expected and needed. My house is where your life task, your mission, is waiting for you. Without it, you keep running in circles. All you need to do is three things:*

- Ask me to pay your open bills (with my cross).
- Ask me to adopt you – and I will do it.
- Stick to my brilliant house rules and our friendship works out.

Many know that indistinct feeling inside *to be homesick for a country to which they have never been*. Instinctively, every human knows that in the very beginning, in the Garden of Eden, man lived together with God. This original relationship broke apart because man allowed himself to be lied to, and deceived. He broke the one house rule that existed then – *don't touch that one particular tree!* Man got kicked out and God made a fence around the garden. This primal catastrophe is like a break-up between father and child that cannot be ignored. Anyone who sees a beautiful garden can make the test to find out if there is that little voice in him, saying, "That is where you belong; going on walks with God. Eat and laugh with him in His garden." And you know instinctively: I am standing on the wrong side of the fence. How do I get inside?

Jesus and Lampedusa

Lampedusa is a tiny island in the Mediterranean. Almost daily, overloaded boats from North Africa arrive there with refugees. It is their door to the promised land, Europe. The central message of Jesus had only seven words: **Become naturalized because my Kingdom is here!** Statistically, Jesus spoke a hundred times about a Kingdom ruled by him; only twice did he speak of church. The churches have turned these statistics around. Jesus is not the founder of a new religion and not even the founder of the Church as we know it — people have turned him into this position. In reality, he founded a country! The Greek word *ekklesia*, translated "church" in most Bibles, actually means *the parliament of all eligible persons above 20 years of age* in the Greek city-states of old. *Ekklesia* is a *political* word, not a *religious* one! When Jesus says, "I will build my *ekklesia*" some Bibles translate it as: "I will build my church." In reality, it should say, "**I will build my government.**" That is a huge difference!

During the days of the Roman Empire, when a new Caesar was to be crowned, religious bird watchers called *augurs* waited to see if the eagle would land on the chosen one. Do you remember that at the time of His baptism, a dove landed on Jesus? Anyone then would understand the symbolism here: a new Caesar has been chosen, *inaugurated*. But he will not rule under the sign of a brutal eagle, but that of a gentle dove. Now that was something completely new!

The country founded and ruled by Jesus is called **The Kingdom of God**. Because its seat of government is heaven, it is sometimes called the Kingdom of Heaven. This Kingdom is the realm of God's uncontested rule, his sovereign territory in which his law is binding.

What does this have to do with Lampedusa? Simple. Jesus once said, **"I am the door."** Through me, you enter into my Kingdom. The Kingdom is God's new Garden of Eden! This is where Jesus is both King and immigration chief at the same time. Only He is handing out a citizenship that cannot be paid for by the money of man; only He issues the passports. Just like Lampedusa is for many the door to Europe, Jesus is the door to the Kingdom.

The house rules of God

Almost every country has a constitution, a collection of core foundational laws, without which there would be no rule of law. The Kingdom of God also has such a constitution. The Greek word *dikaiosyne*, incorrectly translated in most Bibles as "righteousness," simply means "*life according to ruling law*." It is about constitutionality. The famous words of Jesus in chapter six of the Gospel of Matthew (vs 33) does not read: "Seek first the Kingdom of God and his righteousness", but: **"Seek first the Kingdom of God and his constitution, then everything else will be added to you."** Just before Jesus went back home to the seat of government, he gave his governors, the apostles (they were his political ambassadors, officials with legal authority) a final order: **"Teach them to obey everything that I have commanded you."** If we count all the commands of Jesus, we find that he issued exactly 75 of them. Many Christians believe Jesus did not say *commanded* but *recommended*. Most translators even forgot to include the exclamation marks after his commands. Therefore, without binding law, without the house rules of God, chaos rules.

The body of the 75 laws of Christ are the constitution of the Kingdom, the house rules of God. To mention some here: **In everything, do to others, as you would have them do to you! Give, and it will be given! Do not steal! Do not lie! Love each other! Forgive each other! Do not hoard! Beware of all kinds of greed! Make friends by using unrighteous wealth! Love your enemies! Do not fear!**

Let us be honest: Do *you* know of a country where this is binding law? Where something like this is part of the constitution? When I realized that, I knew this is to where I want to move. To such a King and such a constitution, I can — and will! — submit myself.

A GEF-free space (GEF: Greed, Ego, Fear)

And here is a key that we should not overlook. Greed and fear, the two biggest slave drivers of mankind, have no space in the Kingdom of God. There are two reasons for this. God delivers us from our own inflated ego and its constant desire to have and have more. **When you enter the Kingdom, you leave your ego at the door.** If you have God, you do not need status symbols any longer, even being insured against all eventualities is not important any longer. The second reason is, that in the presence of God greed and fear implode like a house of cards. If you are being showered with privileges like love, acceptance and forgiveness, cheap emotions like avarice or the

constant fear to miss out suddenly evaporate. It would be right to say that the Kingdom of God has a completely different power grid. It is not a mere 110 or 220 volts that comes out of the sockets, but high voltage, something more like 30,000 volts. Anyone powered by this grid will see how greed and fear collapse like a punctured balloon. Did we say that money rules the world? Yes, but only as long as there is no one that has a power stronger than money. And that someone is the Holy Spirit. When you become a naturalized citizen of the Kingdom, you will be empowered by Him when you demonstrate loyalty to the King and his constitution. Just like in real life. If you want to work for a government – as a civil servant, a soldier, police officer, judge — you have to swear an oath of allegiance to the constitution. Otherwise, you receive no executive powers. This is why politicians have to swear an oath of office, where they declare: *I am no longer a private person, but I am a legal person under public law. From this time onwards, I am subject to the constitution.* Only after this moment, the official swearing in, a transfer of executive power takes place — not before. It is the same in the Kingdom of God. Only after your oath of allegiance to Jesus, the King, and to His constitution, the power transfer on you takes place. Otherwise, it would be like giving under-aged children posts as ministers, or give them weapons, billions of dollars or state secrets. The official symbolic act of swearing our allegiance to the Kingdom is baptism, voluntarily giving away our old life, including our ego, greed and fears. From now on, we are owned and operated by our new King, Jesus Christ. The Apostle Peter said exactly this in his famous speech at Pentecost: **Repent** (be saved, become naturalized) **and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ, then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** When the Jewish theologians got angry that God would use ordinary people to turn their city upside down, Peter underlined again: **God is giving the Holy Spirit to those who obey him.** Most Christians have never heard this in church. Or experienced it. No one has ever told them what Jesus was very sternly declaring to his followers: **if you love me, obey my commandments.** Even the very last page of the Bible says it yet again: **Blessed are those that keep his commands.** This does not speak of the Ten Commandments of Moses, but of the **Law of Christ**, the new Moses, and the sum total of His 75 laws. God does not bless disobedience. Anyone that does not keep the Law of Christ is not blessed. And that means he does not receive real, high voltage power from God. The result is that he may call himself a Christian, but actually leads a powerless and domesticated life. Untreated greed and fear are still very much part of his operating system. Such a person may be a church member and have a Bible or a songbook somewhere, but he has not become part of the solution, but still remains a part of the problem. He may say, sing or even preach: **Lord, Lord!**, but does not do what the Lord tells him. And this Lord once said: **You are my friends, if you do what I command.**

That is why many are literally stuck in an ICE pack, particularly a religious one.

Life on board the ICE-breaker of God is very different. When a person submits himself to Jesus Christ as his King, he is not only under orders of this King; he now also functions in His authority – *the high voltage of the Kingdom.* Many have a God; *but only a few have an acting king.* But the moment we enter

His service, our entire personality experiences a reset, a complete reinvention of ourselves. It is like a computer that is receiving a new operating system without viruses and constant system crashes. All destructive lies and borrowed identities we have picked up are debunked and become powerless, because we suddenly can hear that voice that tells us the truth about ourselves: *you are an ingenious idea of God — His invention, His secret weapon. You are somebody, you are capable, you have a great mission!* To know that is one of the priceless privileges of being a citizen of the Kingdom.

Embassies of the Kingdom

Our individual re-invention is just the beginning. Suddenly, our social co-existence experiences an upgrade. If we do not know the possibilities and standards in the Kingdom, we would simply exclaim, “Share with others!? Impossible, a utopian idea!” But if greed and fear are the driving forces, the spirit behind an “iced” world, then their opposites, selfless sharing and trusting love, are the only way to break the ICE. If Jesus is the only true icebreaker, we can even move through pack ice; the impossible becomes possible. This is exactly what the first citizens of the Kingdom did. It says about them: **They shared with each other and had everything in common. No one among them was in need. Because all those that had more than they needed sold their companies and houses (if they had more than one) and turned them into money, which was distributed so that everyone had all he needed.**

Imagine a group of people who would actually do this today! It would be a sensation! Many talk of sharing and solidarity, but few actually live this. Wherever people start to base their lives on this economic principle, we will witness the emergence of a revolutionary cell that has declared war on greed and fear.

Communism has tried it, but did not understand nor quite expect the power of the GEF-virus (greed, ego, fear). Many flat-sharing communities, communes or kibbutzim have failed here as well. They simply could not get rid of the GEF-virus.

So where could something like that begin? **Where two or three are together in my name, I am in their midst**, says Jesus. This means that where two or more are submitting to Jesus as their King, they now have a *common political foundation*. This is how an embassy of the Kingdom is started on earth, just like a political embassy of nation X in nation Y is a sovereign territory on Y’s turf.

If such a community commits to the Constitution of the Kingdom, they even have a *common legal foundation*. And if they finally commit to live by the economy of the Kingdom (where you give and receive, not buy and sell), then they also have a *common economic foundation*. Such communities will experience the 30,000 volts, the high voltage of the Kingdom, and will turn into houses that change the world. What would hinder you to do just that? Shake it off. The time will come where we will stand before Jesus and He will ask all of us: “What did you do with the time, money and talents I gave you? Wasted, squandered?” This is the time when all those that remained on the wrong side of the fence will find themselves in a very, very uncomfortable situation.

Colonies of the Kingdom

Our sons all play football. As a family we find ourselves involved in an international tournament that sometimes gets us to visit *Ramstein Air Base*. Behind a big fence — it is more like a border — we find a “Little America” on German turf. Shops, restaurants, banks, schools — you get the impression that every screw has been imported from the USA. It is like being in another world. But even more effectively than the USA, the Kingdom of God is a nation that *permeates all other nations*. Constantly, new people join it. That is why the Kingdom is expanding; heaven colonizes earth. These colonies of the Kingdom are the new Gardens of Eden. They emerge where a critical mass, a number of Kingdom embassies join together. Those colonies need bold founders, people who are ready to model the alternative of God to the systemic lies the enemy of God has sown. This will lead to the emerging of a *state within a state*, a parallel society, micro-nations of the King. They function a bit like a cooperative, a co-op with a trillionaire (God) at the table. Everyone who wants to join will be asked: *What do you bring? What do you need?* People in such colonies live optimized, not maximized. Everyone has what he needs and gives what he can.

The re-invention of the world

Wherever God finds people who are truly loyal to him, he is ready to show them some of his state secrets. Some of these are highly explosive secrets for which the occupants of the pack ice would give their right arm. The risen Jesus is known to have said: **I make everything new**. If we take that literally, then Jesus would be the initiator of a truly gigantic innovation project; everything is going to be new, individuals, households, all aspects of life, regions, nations, and the whole world. This is why I sometimes call Jesus “the patron saint of innovators.” I am not surprised to observe how He releases such an innovative force, inspiration and vision that people become IPEs, *game changing inventors, pioneers and entrepreneurs*. Their innovations are of a quality that goes far beyond anything that a world iced over can produce. They touch every aspect of life, family, money, sex, power, health, energy, education, business, and government. Such people are the prophetic avant-garde of a development that has already begun and will become mainstream for the whole world. Because this Jesus prophesied that He will come again to rule the earth with people who belong to Him, leading to a complete re-invention of life. Let us summarize this process in three steps:

1. God has created this world in an ingenious fashion: *“God saw it was very good!”*
2. Humans rebelled against God and poisoned themselves and the world with greed. Since then, every day the media screams, *“It became very bad!”*
3. Where former homeless rebels submit again to God as their King, colonies of heaven emerge here on earth. Such places become a prophetic model, an ark of God, a shopping window of the Kingdom to show that nothing is impossible for God. Anyone who sees this will exclaim, *“Look, this is pretty incredible!”*

Now, do you really have something better to do than to be part of *this*?

What could you do next?

- Maybe the ideas expressed here are new for you. Then take your time to digest this perspective. It may have taken you 30 minutes to read this booklet, but it will take some time and space to re-adjust some of the “iced” perceptions you have contracted in the last 30 years. Give it time to melt.
- Friends of mine used to say, “*If nothing happens, happen yourself.*” I agree. Someone needs to take initiative. If not you, then who? And if not now, then when? You don’t have to start an embassy or colony by tomorrow. But begin to warm up towards a true alternative to an “iced” society. Ideally, you begin at square one. Become a citizen of the Kingdom today. Because, first we have to get rid of the GEF-virus in ourselves before we can go out and change the world. No matter what your background is, your true home has been waiting for you for a long time.
